Authorization is given to take the following species of wild animals that are causing or threatening to cause damage to property or posing a health or safety threat to persons or domestic animals in accordance with 312 IAC 9-10-11: beaver, muskrat, coyote, red fox, gray fox, striped skunk, raccoon, opossum, eastern cottontail rabbit, fox squirrel, gray squirrel, southern flying squirrel, red squirrel, groundhog, mink, long-tailed weasel, bats (non-endangered species only), and reptiles (non-endangered species only)

1. Valid for use only by the permit holder named above and the following assistants: Bill Haehn, Nate Metzger, Cody Pack, Trevor Webb, Matt McConnehea, Keith Kimmet, and Josh Clouse. Assistants must have a copy of this permit in their possession when conducting activities authorized under this permit.
2. Locations where authorized: Statewide.
3. May use the following methods: Cage (Live) Trap, Firearm, Air Rifle, Foot/Leg-hold Trap, Body-gripping Trap (conibear), Snare, Hand Capture, Crossbow, Net, Snake Hook or Tongs, or Catch-pole. Firearms must be used in accordance with local ordinances. Animals may be released within the county of capture on property where you have permission or be euthanized by an approved method.
4. Carry this permit when conducting any activities authorized under this permit.
